Dear Parents

The students have had another busy month and are focussing well on their studies whilst managing their extracurricular activities. It is great to see so many students involved in such a large array of activities, from sporting pursuits to musical interests.

Preparation for Student/Parent/Teacher meetings in weeks 5 & 6 is well underway with much focus going towards student reflection about their year and looking forward to grade 8 and the challenges they will face in the new year. The interviews are really about having a 3-way conversation with the student, their parents and teacher about the reflections that each student presents. You should all have received an appointment slip via your child this week. Please contact your child's class teacher if the time you have been allocated no longer works for you to ensure an alternative time can be arranged.

As is the norm, most students are in possession of a smart phone. This is a great way for you to be able to contact your child if there are issues with travel, sporting cancellations and the like. As it can be extremely disruptive to students, we would ask that rather than ringing your child, you leave them a text conveying your message or asking them to ring you when it is convenient for them to do so. If it is extremely urgent that you contact your child, we would ask that you ring reception, so a message can be given to the teacher to pass onto the student. Students are not allowed to use their phones in class without express permission from their teacher. Similarly, they must ask grade 7 staff for permission to make a call during break time.

It is terrific to see so many students involved in the intermediate production that will be performed early in term 4. Rehearsals are well underway in lunch hours and it is heartening to see students willingly giving up their free time to be a part of this.

You should now have received a request for parent assistance for the Maria Island camp via your child. If you are intending to put in a form, I would urge you to do so at your earliest convenience as there are usually many more requests than positions to be filled.
