# Alumni Scholarship

Broadland House Old Girls' Association  
For students entering Grade 11

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## INTRODUCTION

The Broadland House Old Girls' Association Scholarship is open to new and currently enrolled students who will be entering into Grade 11 or 12 in 2020. Applications are invited from students whose parent(s), grandparent(s) or near relatives graduated from Broadland House Church of England Girls' Grammar School or Launceston Church Grammar School and who can demonstrate outstanding achievement in their academic studies as well as in one or two of the following areas: sport; music; the arts; leadership; or community service. In addition to the above, students will be required to provide examples in their introduction letter of how they have or will meet the General Scholarship Criteria set out below:

- Setting a good example in every respect inside and outside the classroom;
- Demonstrating positive School spirit;
- Willingly meeting all obligations as defined by staff;
- Being involved in and supporting school functions and activities;
- Being exemplary in their appearance and wearing of the School's uniform; and
- Making a full contribution to the School's co-curricular activities programme and to the general life of the School, and continue their enrolment at the School to the end of Grade 12.

The Scholarship is awarded to no more than two students receiving part remission of tuition fees (up to 50% concession) and is tenable until the end of Grade 12.



## APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications **must** include the following:

- Broadland House Old Girls' Association Scholarship Application Form;
- Handwritten letter of introduction (by the student), addressed to the Headmaster, Mr Richard Ford. The letter is to include examples of how the student has or will meet the General Scholarship Criteria set out above and outline interests and specific academic/career goals for life beyond secondary school;
- Two references from members of the community;
- Copy of the student's two school reports;
- Copy of the student's NAPLAN report(s); and
- Copy of certificates of achievement/accolades/ ICAS results etc, as appropriate (please limit to just a few awards).

Failure to include all documentation noted above may result in the application not being considered.

Applications will not be returned therefore we ask that only copies of reports and certificates be supplied. Material should be no larger than A4 size and should come stapled (please do not place material in a presentation folder).

Applications close at 5.00pm on Friday 31 May 2019.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview with their parents to meet with a panel of the Broadland House Old Girls Association and the Headmaster and/or member of the School Executive.

All applicants will be informed of the outcome of their application once interviews have concluded.
