# G.L. Stubs Educational Trust Scholarship

For new students entering Grade 7  
to Grade 12

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## INTRODUCTION

The G.L. Stubs Educational Trust Scholarship was established by the Stubs family who have had a longstanding connection with the Launceston Church Grammar School. Geoffrey Lewis Stubs attended Launceston Grammar from 1935-1938. Geoffrey was a scholarship holder and held the Williatt-Moore Scholarship and Thomas Fall Scholarship. Geoffrey's aunt, Florence Lilian Stubs, was the Headmistress of Grammar Prep School from 1946-1954.

The G.L. Stubs Educational Trust Scholarship was established for the purpose of advancing the educational opportunities of students entering Grade 7 to Grade 12 in 2020 and whose financial circumstances would otherwise prevent them from enrolling at the School. Students will be required to demonstrate outstanding achievement in their academic studies as well as in one or two of the following areas: sport; music; the arts; leadership; or community service. In addition to the above, students will be required to provide examples in their introduction letter of how they will meet the General Scholarship Criteria set out below:

- Setting a good example in every respect inside and outside the classroom;
- Demonstrating positive School spirit;
- Willingly meeting all obligations as defined by staff;
- Being involved in and supporting school functions and activities;
- Being exemplary in their appearance and wearing of the School's uniform; and
- Making a full contribution to the School's co-curricular activities programme and to the general life of the School, and continue their enrolment at the School to the end of Grade 12.

Successful applicants will receive part remission of tuition fees (up to 50% concession) and is tenable until the end of Grade 12. The G.L. Stubs Educational Trust Scholarship will take into account parents' financial means.

Scholarships will be reviewed after two years and will continue subject to satisfactory progress of the student, taking into account the student's School reports, feedback provided by various members of staff and the student's adherence to the General Scholarship Criteria.



## APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications **must** include the following:

- G.L. Stubs Educational Trust Scholarship Application Form;
- Handwritten letter of introduction (by the student), addressed to the Headmaster, Mr Richard Ford. The letter is to include examples of how the student will meet the General Scholarship Criteria set out above and outline interests and specific academic/career goals for life beyond secondary school;
- Completed Financial Information Form (with supporting documentation);
- Copy of the student's two school reports;
- Copy of the student's NAPLAN report(s); and
- Copy of certificates of achievement/accolades/ ICAS results etc, as appropriate (please limit to just a few awards).

Failure to include all documentation noted above may result in the application not being considered.

Applications will not be returned therefore we ask that only copies of reports and certificates be supplied. Material should be no larger than A4 size and should come stapled (please do not place material in a presentation folder).

Applications close at 5.00pm on Friday 31 May 2019.
