Lesson fees for 2024: \$40 per 30 minute lesson and \$60 per 45 minute lesson. Lessons for two students together are available for \$50 per half hour. Lesson charges will be invoiced to you. Please note that charges are made at the start of the term for the reservation of that lesson timeslot with the tutor. You will be charged for 8 lessons per term to allow for student illness or school excursions. For extenuating circumstances, lessons may be reimbursed at the discretion of the director of music. In the unlikely event that the tutor is unwell or cannot deliver the lesson, you will be either offered a make up lesson or the lesson will be reimbursed at the end of the term. If your child is unable to attend a lesson please notify the tutor either via email or SMS by 8:00am as a courtesy to the tutor on the day. Please understand that you will not be reimbursed for that lesson, as your fees reserve that time slot with the tutor. Discontinuation: Music lessons are to be regarded as a year long commitment. However, should the need arise to discontinue lessons, the school requires at three weeks notice in writing from a parent/carer to be forwarded to the Director of Music (MRogers@lcgs.tas. edu.au). Your term fees will not be reimbursed for discontinuation. Practice: It is expected that students taking instrumental lessons will practice regularly at home between lessons. Students will gain the most benefit by regular practice at home. Please ensure they have an instrument on which to practice at home. If needed, the school has instruments available for hire. If you have any feedback or concerns about your child's progress, please contact the tutor or the Director of Music.
