#### Levy Inclusions

The non-refundable levy incorporates subject charges, compulsory excursions and outdoor education camps, sport and activities, facilities, resources, etexts, computing, School publications and administration costs. Refunds will not be provided in the case of non-participation.

#### Insurance Cover For Property and Medical Expenses

Please note the School has full liability insurance but it does not cover lost property. There is a student accident policy that provides limited cover for medical expenses not otherwise reimbursed.

#### Casual and Day Boarding

Casual and day boarding options are available on request for day students to cater for family needs.

- Casual boarding \$205 per night
- Day boarding \$50 per evening

Part-time boarding available - minimum commitment of one term.

#### Sibling Allowance - Tuition

The School offers a reduction in tuition fees for full-time siblings attending the School at the same time (excluding Early Learning):

- Second child 15%
- Third 45%
- Fourth 75%
- Fifth 100%

#### Payment

Fees will be divided into 10 equal payments from February to November and payable by the due date on the statement. EFTPOS, Direct Debit and BPAY are available as payment options. Please note that all credit card payments will incur a 1% surcharge if made over the phone or in person at the office.

**Advanced Payment Discount:** A discount of 4.5% will apply if annual tuition and boarding fees are paid in full by 6 February 2026.

#### Student Withdrawal

One Terms' notice in writing to the Principal is required prior to withdrawal of a student to avoid an administration charge of \$1,000.

#### Fee Reviews

The Board sets fees for a calendar year to assist parents' planning. However, it reserves the right to adjust tuition and boarding fees at the commencement of a term in the event of any major change in operating costs, such as a major salary or wage increase or any significant change in the pattern of enrolments.
