




## The rights of young people at Launceston Church Grammar School

We at Launceston Grammar believe that young people who participate in our activities, events or programs should:

- Feel comfortable;
- Be cared for;
- Be safe and feel safe;
- Have a right to contact their parents, carers or another trusted adult if they feel unsafe, uncomfortable or distressed at any time during an activity, event or program;
- Be able to take part in activities, events or programs that are suitable for their age and development, and taken by appropriately qualified staff;
- Be supported and helped to make good choices;
- Be provided with clear directions and given an opportunity to redirect their behaviour in a positive manner if staff believe program rules have been broken and/or misbehaviour has occurred;
- Not be subject to disciplinary action involving physical punishment, or any form of treatment that could reasonably be considered degrading, cruel, frightening or humiliating;
- Have the opportunity to contribute suggestions and feedback on an activity, event or program in which they have participated;
- Always be listened to and their feelings believed; and
- Be given access to safe places and safe spaces, and be offered help when needed.
